Easy drop-off and pick-up close to booths; ample and nearby parking for customers
Crestwood Police/Fire headquartered only 1/4 mile away

IN CASE OF SEVERE INCLEMENT WEATHER, fair rescheduled for June 27 - 28.

Sappington House Country Craft Festival Directions

April 25 - 26, 2026, Saturday and Sunday
9 am - 3 pm

Tent and fixtures can be set-up between 4 and 7 pm on Friday, April 24th, and then full set-up starts no earlier than 6:30 am on Saturday, April 25th. Vendors must be set up by 9 am. Drive to 1015 S. Sappington Road 63126 for easy drop-off and pick-up close to booths. After unloading you will need to repark your vehicles across the street at Crestwood Elementary School or in the nearby overflow lot on Reco Avenue. Breakdown on Sunday, April 26 should not begin before 2:30 pm., and the grounds should be cleared by 4 pm.

Be aware that our booth area will be arranged differently because the addition of the 1816 Joseph Sappington Log House will be under construction in the park. Also in case of severe inclement weather, the fair will be rescheduled for June 27 - 28.

Vendors/authors are expected to remain in the fair area and are responsible for their own handiwork and sales. Mass produced or imported products are not permitted. Booths cannot be sublet without the permission of Historic Sappington House.

Sappington House and the City of Crestwood are not liable for theft, damage, personal injury or inclement weather. Risks are assumed by the vendors/authors. Smoking is not permitted on the grounds of Sappington House. Any items or activities deemed potentially hazardous to visitors or the grounds are prohibited and will result in removal from the fair. Violations of any directives will cause the forfeiture of all privileges of participation and fees.

The vendor entry fee for the weekend is \$85 for a 10' x 10' space. Vendors should supply tents/canopies, tables, chairs and any other display fixtures. **We recommend screw-down tent stakes.** Your property must remain within the designated space. Pathways must be kept open. There is no electrical access at booths. Vendors are accountable for sales tax.

Booth rental fees are due no later than Wednesday, April 1. Acknowledgement of all applications will occur on or about Wednesday, April 8. If your application is accepted, your payment will be deposited. If not accepted, your payment will be returned. You may be added to a waiting list and perhaps will be contacted in the case of a cancellation. No cancellations or requests for refund will be honored after Wednesday, April 1. Retain these instructions for future reference.
